RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PEARLINGTON WATER & SEWER DISTRICT DECLARING CERTAIN ASSETS AS SURPLUS PROPERTY HAVING NO VALUE AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION THEREOF

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-001

WHEREAS, the Pearlington Water and Sewer District (the "District") is a public entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of Mississippi, with authority to manage its assets in the best interest of the District and its ratepayers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") has conducted an inventory and evaluation of certain District assets and has determined that the items listed below are obsolete, damaged, or otherwise have no remaining useful value, economic value, or salvageable components, rendering them unsuitable for continued use in District operations; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable laws and District policies, including but not limited to Mississippi Code Annotated § 21-27-11 and any relevant procurement or asset management guidelines, the Board is authorized to declare such assets as surplus property and to dispose of them in an appropriate manner, such as destruction, recycling, or donation to a charitable organization, to avoid unnecessary storage costs and environmental hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Board has verified that no liabilities, liens, or other encumbrances exist on these assets, and their disposition will not impact District operations or finances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Pearlington Water and Sewer District, as follows:

- 1. Declaration of Surplus Assets. The attached list of assets are hereby declared to be surplus property having no value.
- 2. Authorization for Disposition. District employees are hereby authorized and directed to dispose of the surplus assets listed above in a manner deemed most appropriate and cost-effective, including but not limited to secure destruction, recycling through an approved vendor, or donation to a qualified nonprofit entity, with documentation of the disposition provided to the Board for its records.
- 3. Compliance and Reporting. All actions taken pursuant to this Resolution shall comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws, including environmental regulations. District employees shall report back to the Board at the next regular meeting on the status of the disposition.
- 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
